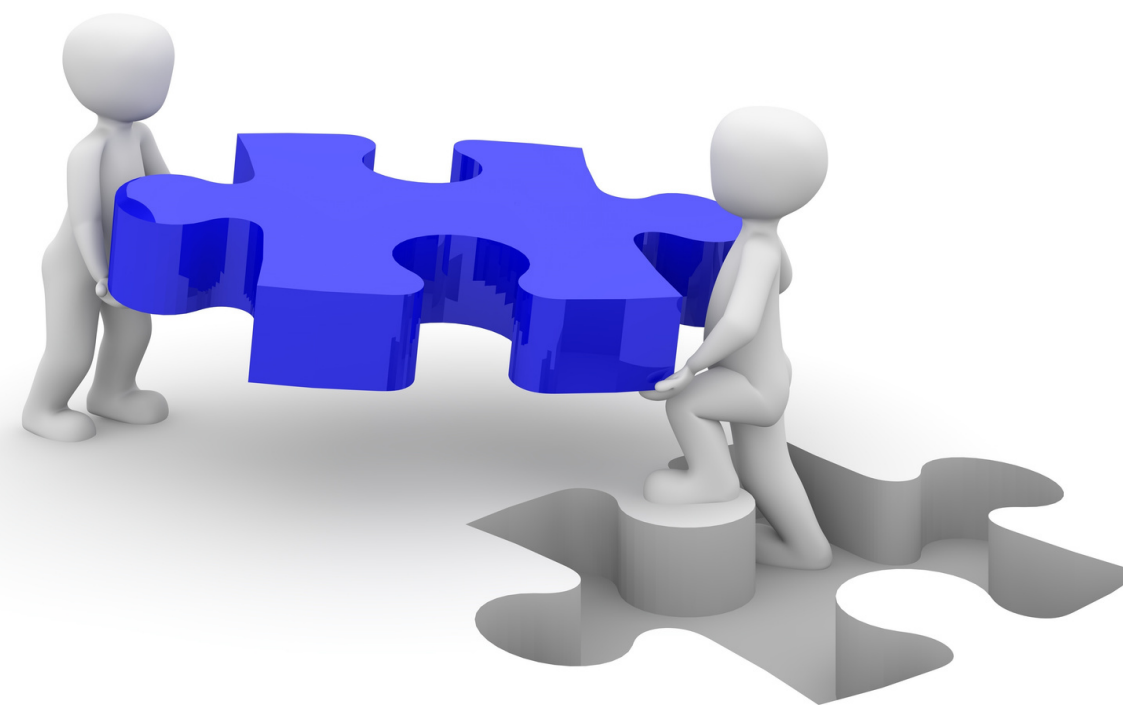

# Where To Find Partners?

- Start Local!
- Non-Profits, For Profit, Government, Coalitions, Schools . . .
- Who is Doing the Same Things You Are?
- Who is Doing the Things You Want to Do?
- Who is Already Using Your Library?
- Who Offers Financial Help to Libraries or Non-Profits?
- Who Needs Your Help?
- Network. Network. Network!



- Be Very Clear and Up Front About Your Needs/Wants/Goals/Expectations
- You Get More With Sugar Than You Do With Salt!
- Follow Up and Follow Through
- Establish Procedures and Ground Rules
- Promote Them Even When It's Not Something You're Partnering On
- Be Up Front About Your Restrictions or Limitations
- Always Keep It Professional

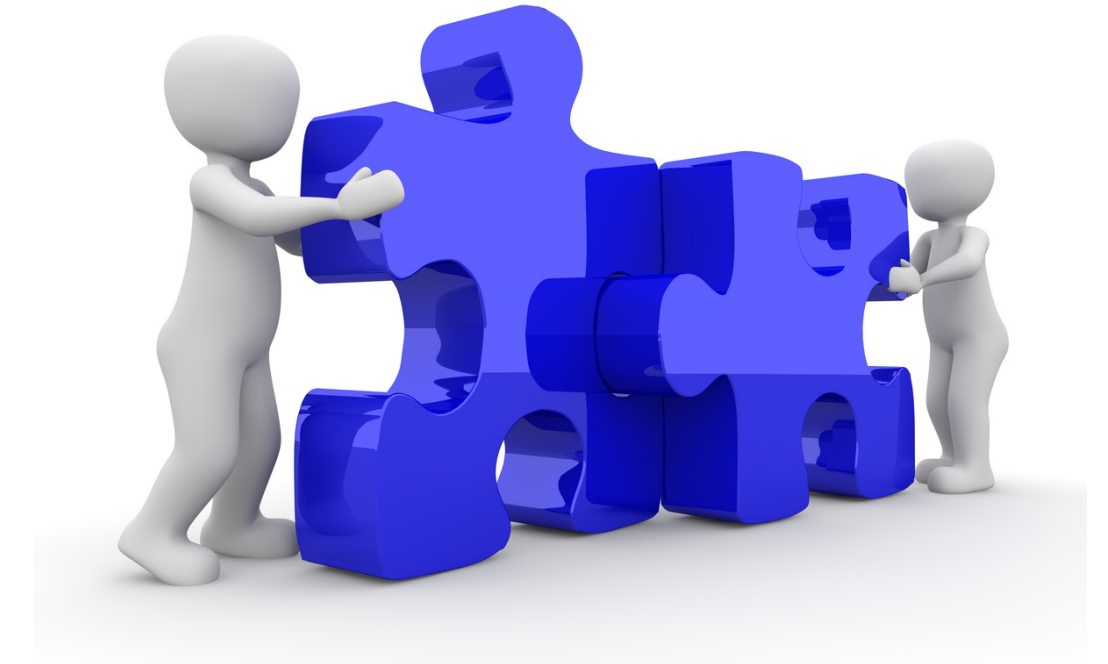

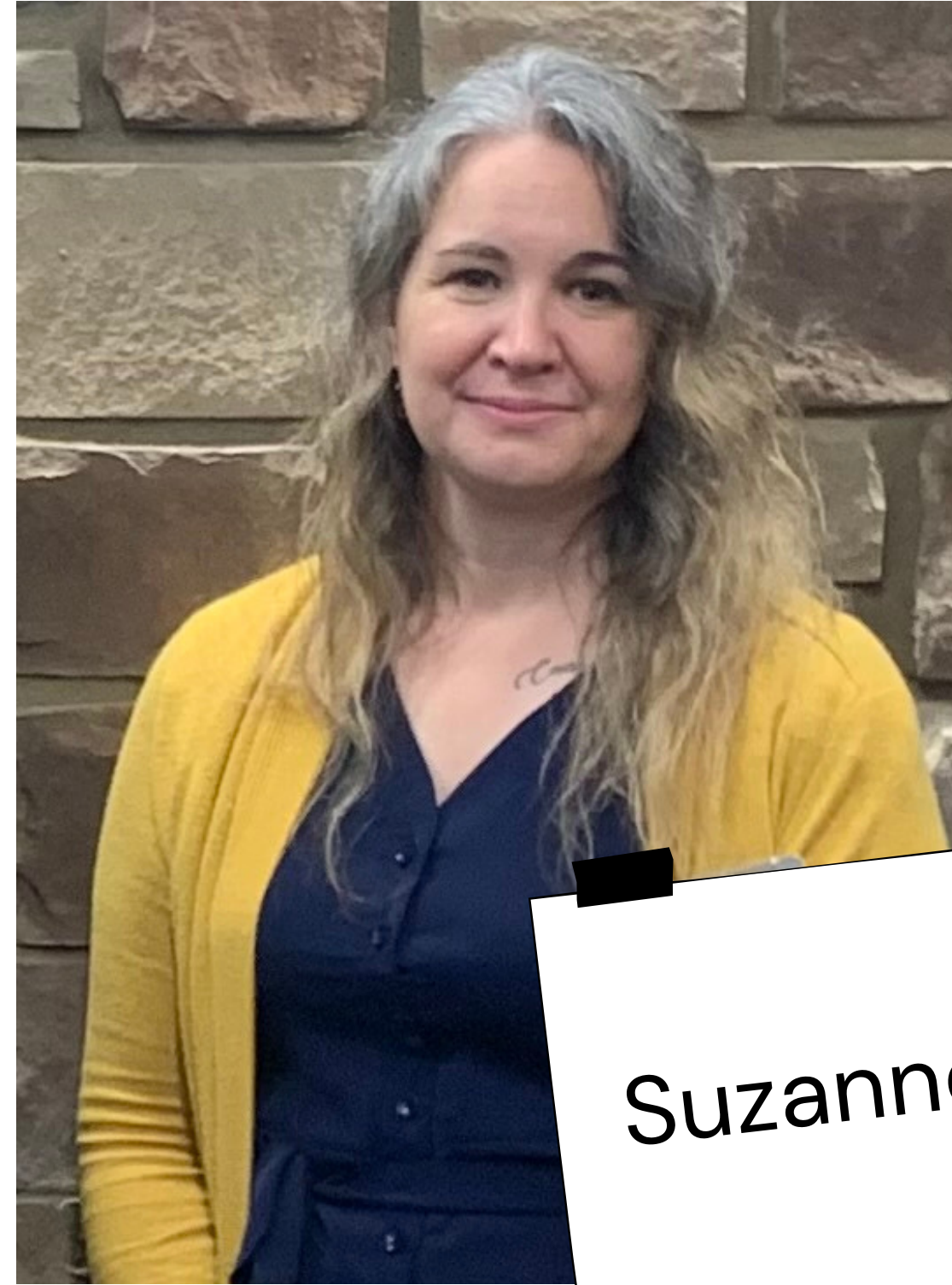
