## Primary Search



### Primary Search (EBSCOhost)

Designed specifically for elementary school libraries, this database contains full text for popular children's magazines, easy-to-read encyclopedia entries and a vast image collection. Students can learn about a variety of topics, such as endangered species, space exploration and more. Primary Search provides students with encyclopedic entries written specifically for kids. In addition, it includes popular magazines including those from Cricket Media, such as Ladybug and Spider. Other magazines include Highlights, Junior Library Guild and more. All full-text articles, many available in color PDF, are assigned reading level indicators (Lexiles) to provide educators with an estimate of reading difficulty and the approximate grade-level reading ability required for comprehension. Lexiles help teachers meet the needs of students with varying reading abilities and interests and allow students to read along at their own pace.

## Homalocephale

Homalocephale was a dinosaur that lived in the late Cretaceous period, about 70 to 80 million years ago. It was about 6 feet long, and most likely ate leaves and branches. Homalocephale was unusual because of its very thick skull and flat head. It is believed to be closely related to Pachycephalosaurus, another thick-skulled dinosaur.
