Covers most of the training requirements and safe work practices for "qualified workers" outlined in OSHA 1910 Subparts. Features five incidents involving electricity in which unsafe acts by employees have resulted in serious injury or death. Topics include: qualified worker status, electrical arcing and arc blasts, protective clothing requirements for qualified workers, limited approach and prohibited approach boundaries, use of voltage-rated gloves and other PPE, performing live work and de-energizing equipment.
