Who's a Fraidy Kat?

Kathleen "Kat" O'Leary is the leader of the school Spirit Squad and popular student at Garden Grove School. But someone is leaving threatening notes in her locker and bedroom. Who would want to scare Kat away from school?

Anyone's Guess Mystery Program Kits (grades 6-9)

Cracks in the Wall

The body of a general contractor is found in the library wall during major repairs. Can concrete evidence bring a murderer to justice?

Death Gets a Red Card

Who would want the popular varsity soccer player dead? Evidence includes a threatening note and a letter from a private school.

The Disappearance of Angela Day

Is she a runaway, or the victim of a crime? Evidence includes a list of stolen cars and a snake tattoo.

Heavy Metal Kidnapping

The mystery is different from the others because it uses a research-based format. The players/detectives must use research sources (web-based and/or paper-text-based) to solve clues and fact-check statements by the suspects.

Murderous Melodrama

Trent Tanner, the male lead in his high school play, was found dead at center stage after the final performance. Did he meet his tragic end at the hands of a dastardly villain?

The Pharaoh's Curse

She was her prom's Queen of the Nile until the accident...or was it attempted murder? Evidence includes a note in hieroglyphics and a summons to appear before the Student Court.

Rock n Roll Over Dead

The music librarian is found dead. Can the Battle of the Bands go on without her?
Evidence includes music lyrics and an order for a pesticide company.
