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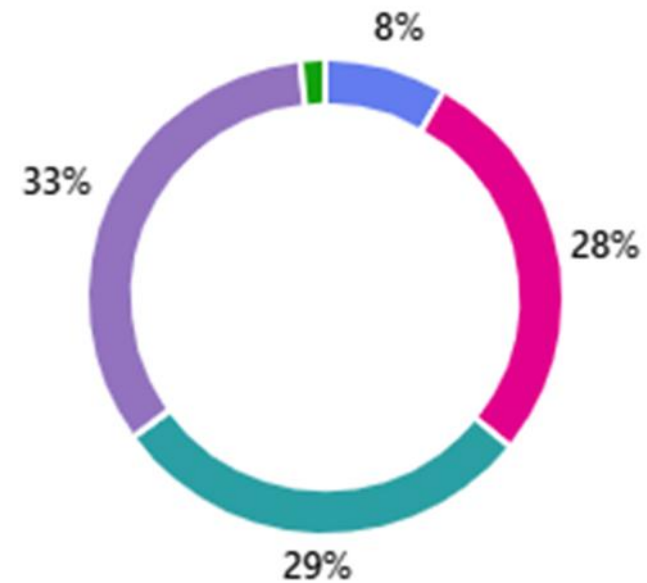

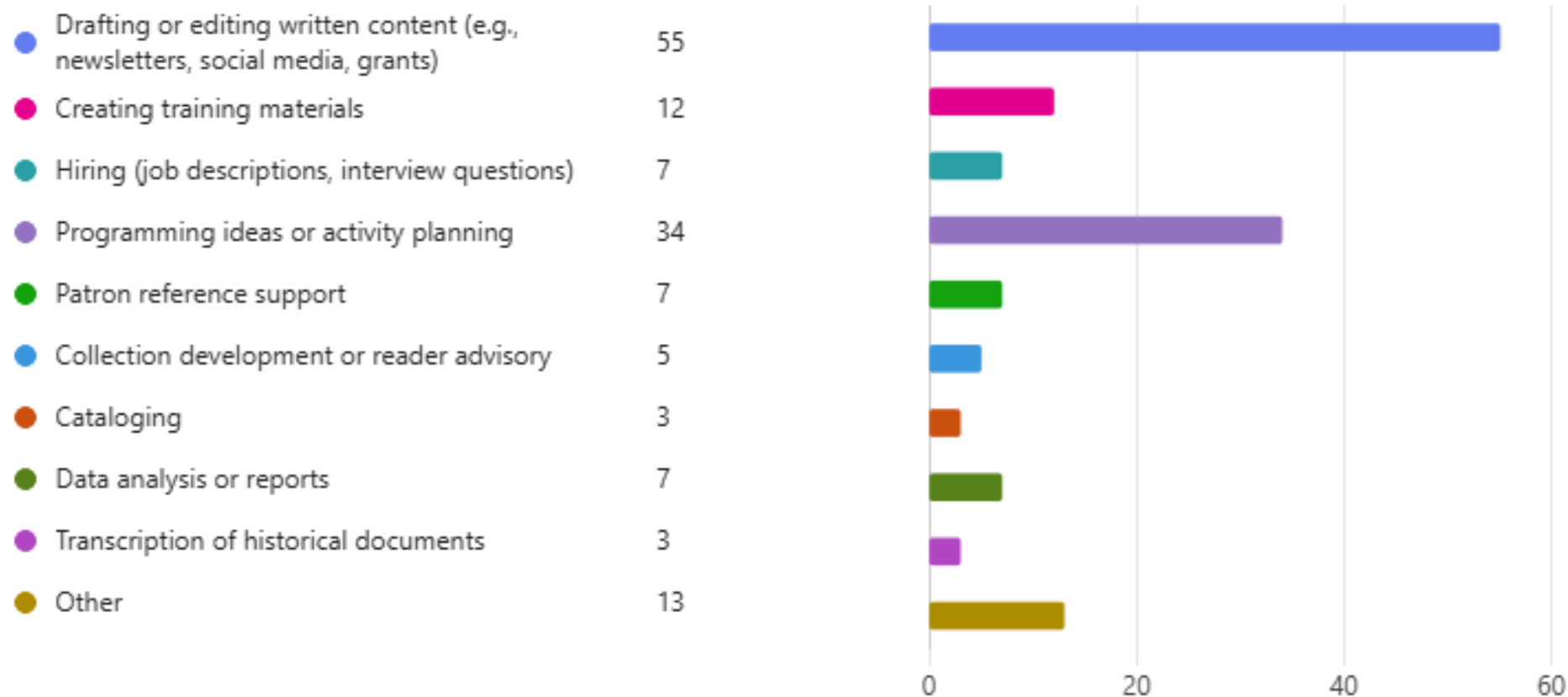
Findings from KY Library survey on AI

Have you used AI tools in your library work?

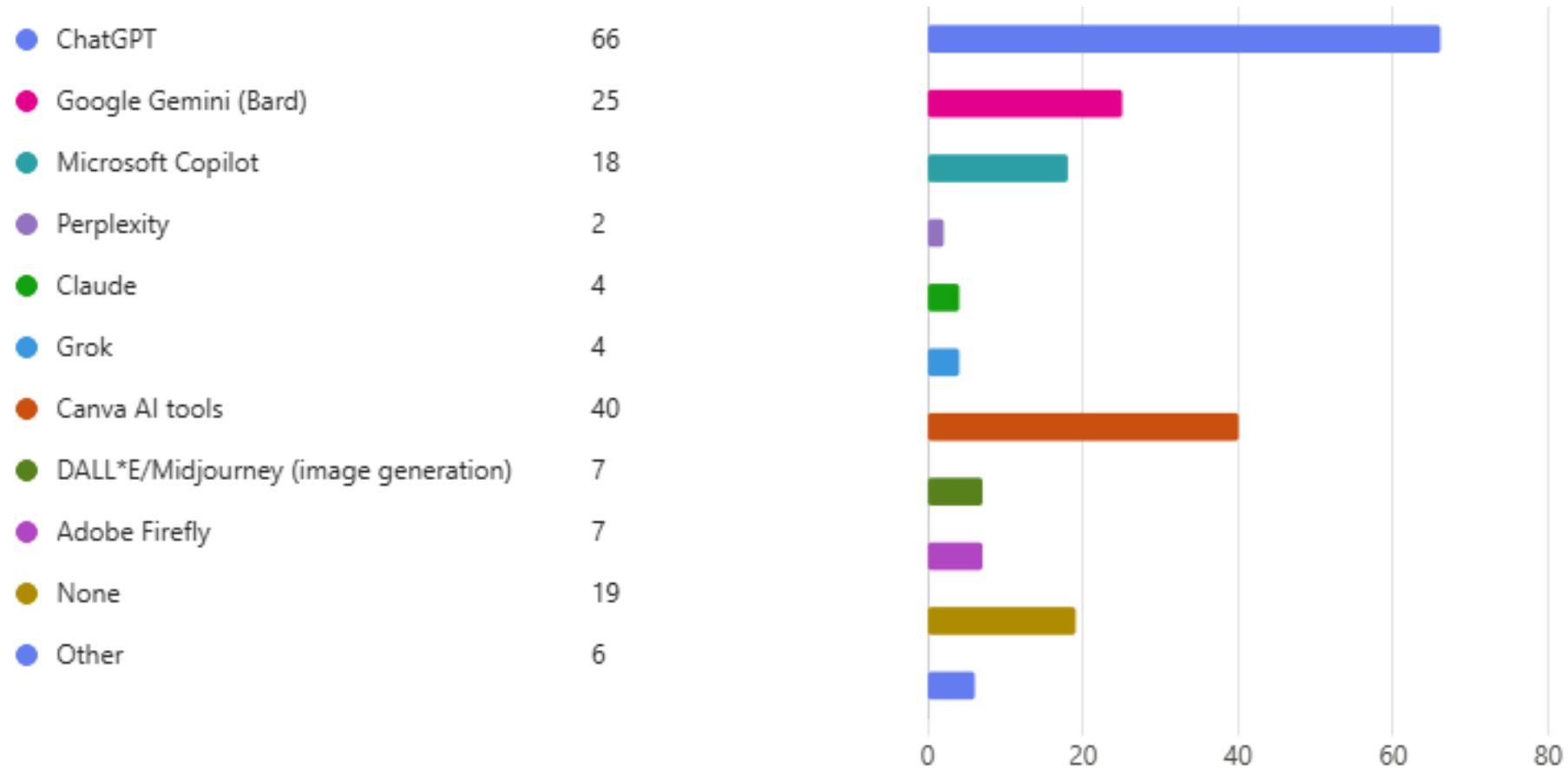
- Yes, regularly

How do you use AI in your work?

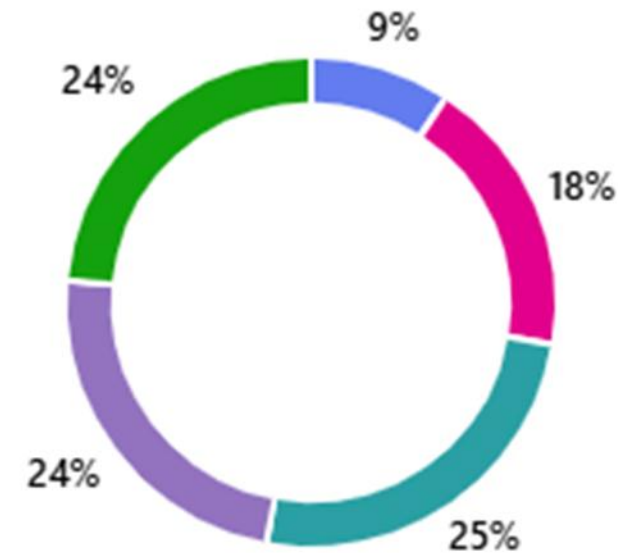


What AI tools have you used?

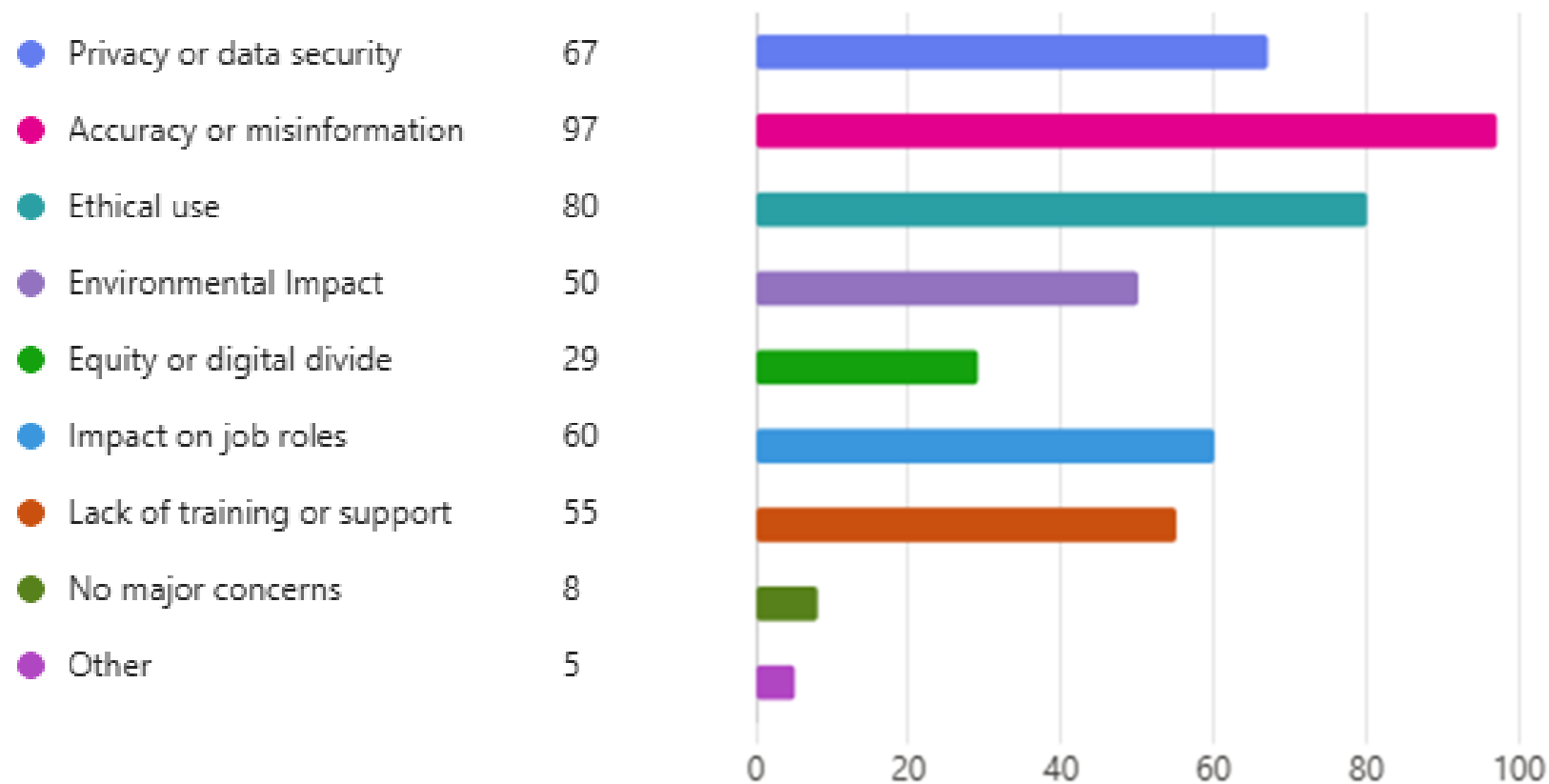


How comfortable are you with using AI tools at work?

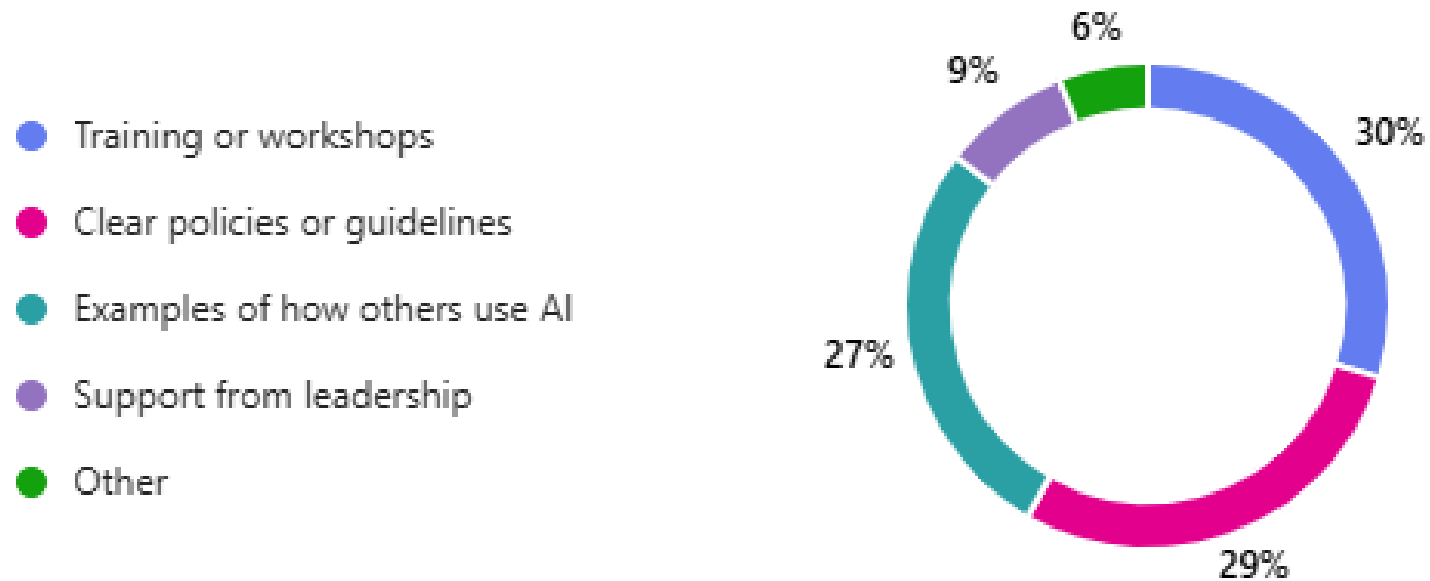
- Very comfortable

What concerns do you have about using AI at the library?



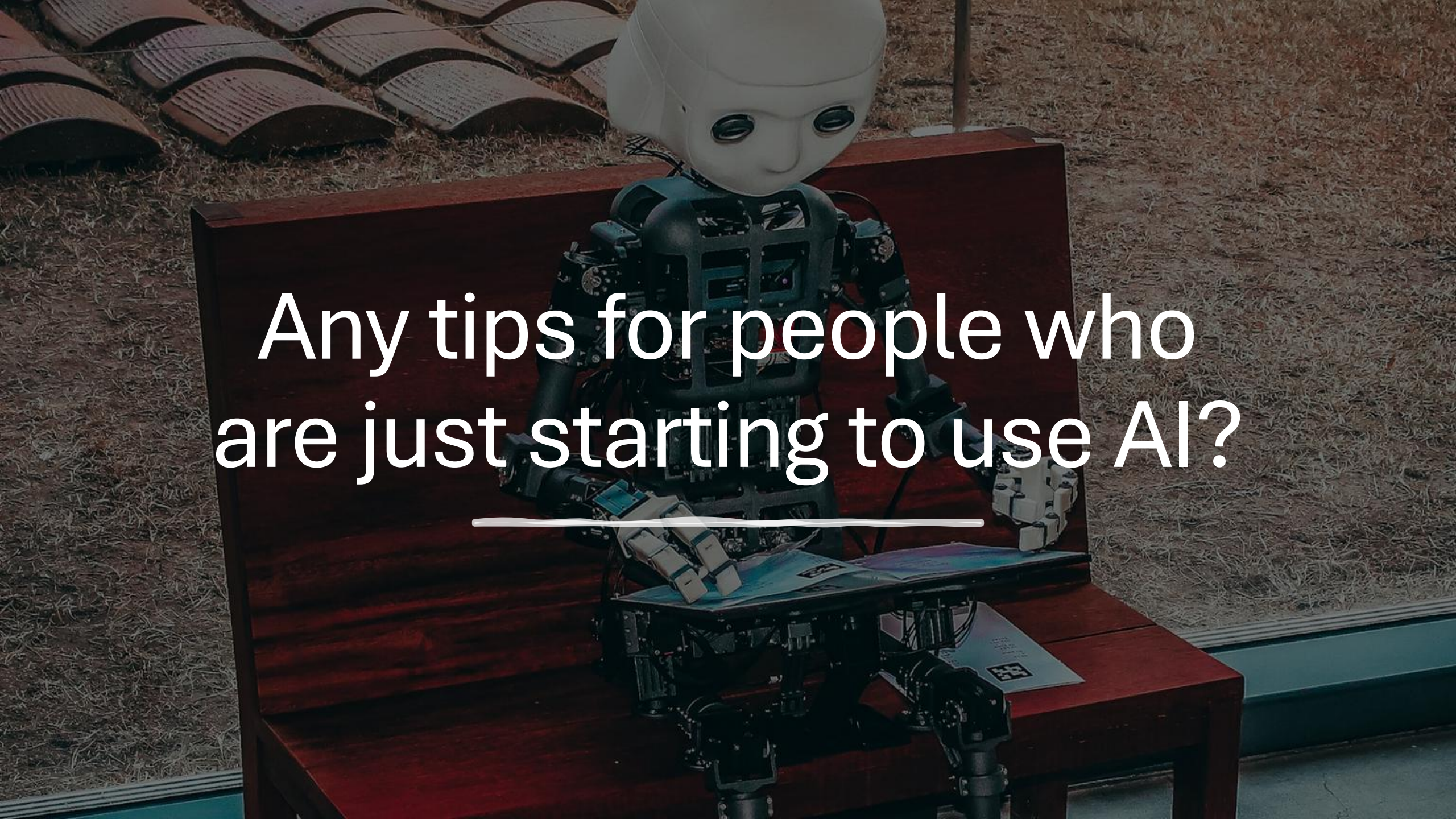

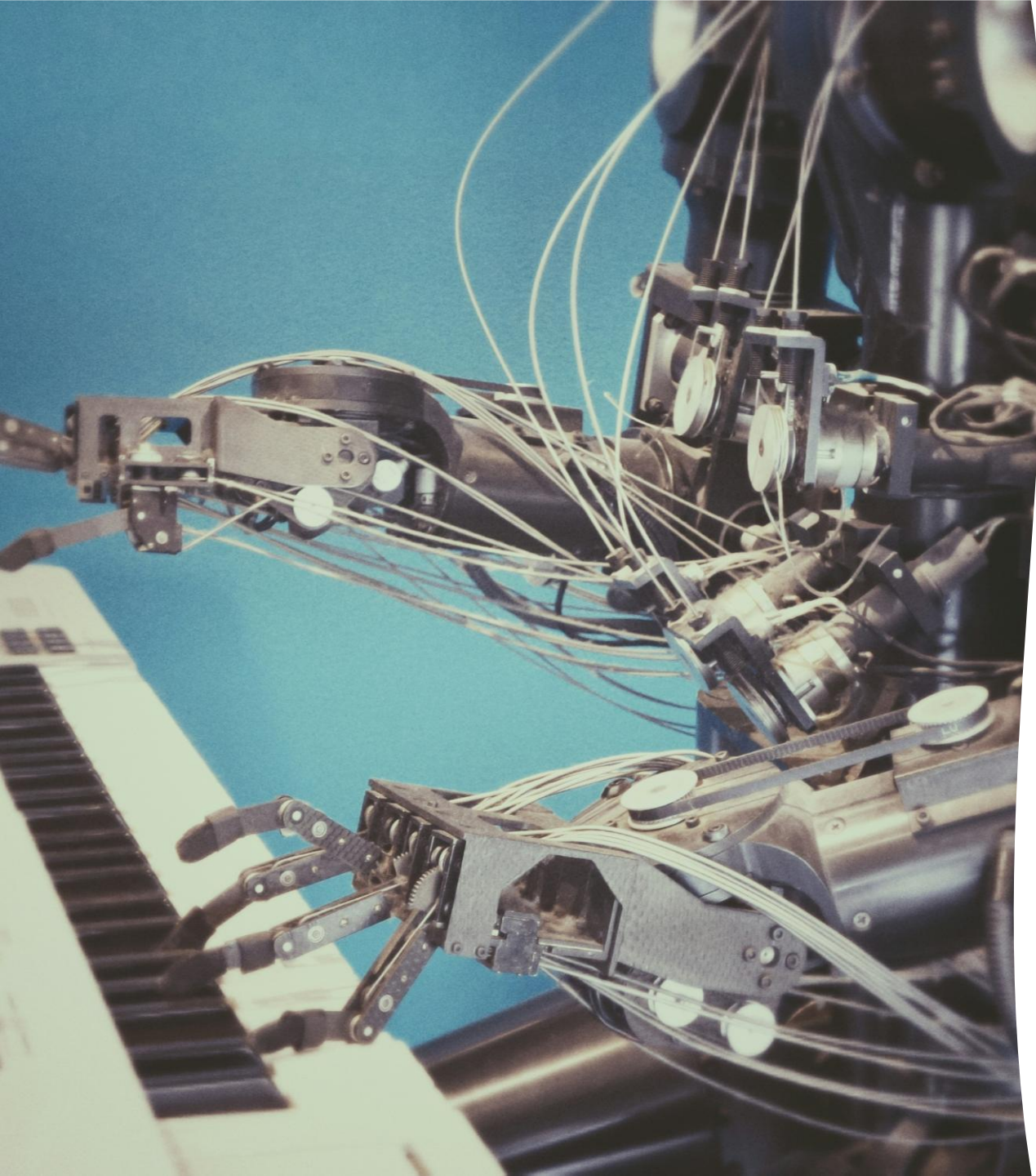

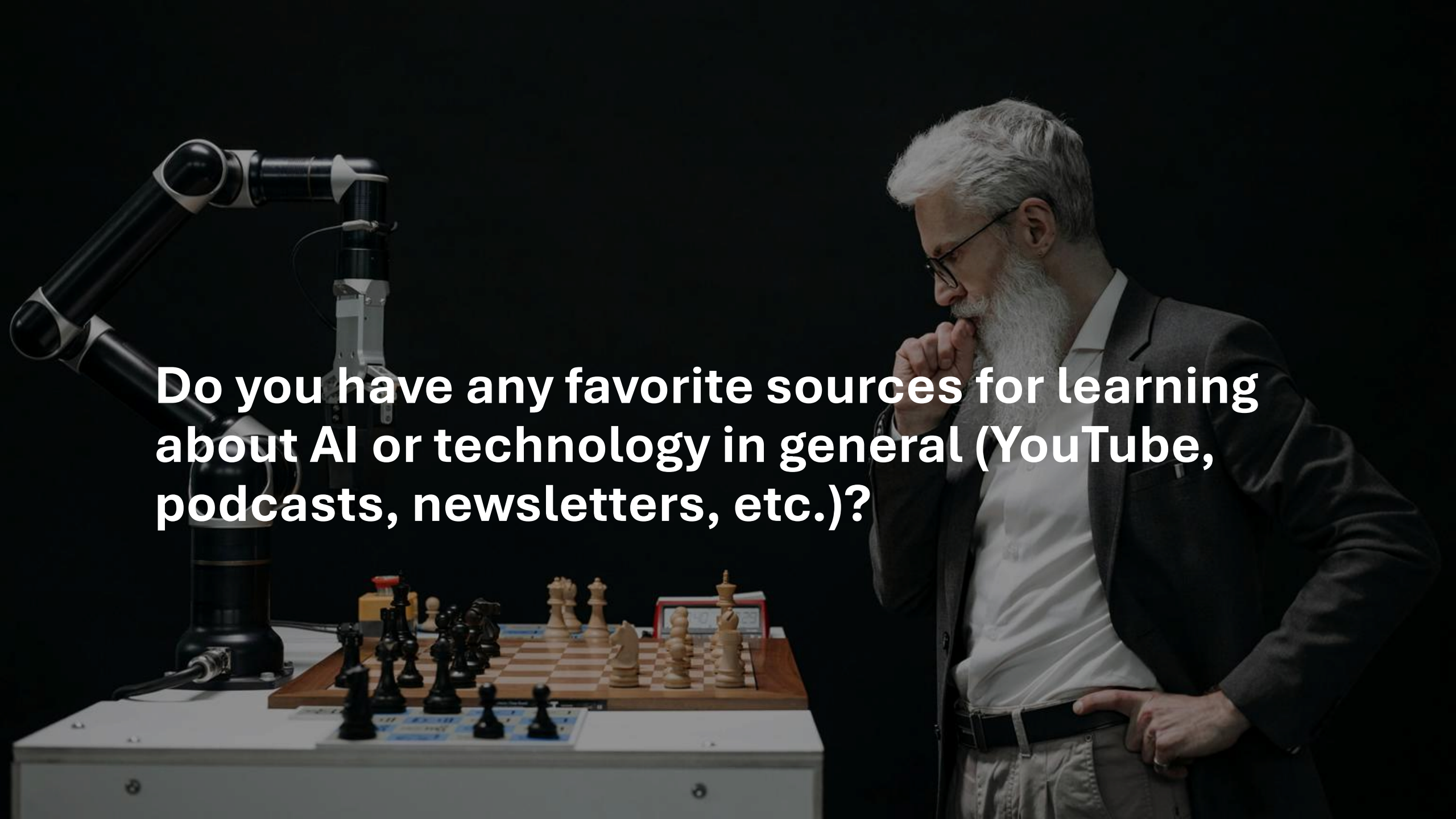
