
INFORMATION THAT APPLIES TO ALL KITS

 Lost and/or damaged items will be charged a replacement fee.
- Some discussion kits may arrive without the full complement of books. The State Library always includes a check out receipt. Your library is only responsible for the items on the that receipt.
- Kits are shipped through the KYVL courier two weeks prior to the date you indicate you need them to arrive at your library. Other arrangements can be made if your library does not receive courier service.
- All kits can also be scheduled to be used by your patrons, either community groups or schools, but must be requested by a library staff member. Please do not ask your patrons to contact the State Library. This only creates confusion and leads to shipping delays.




Reserving a Kit

"Include an audiobook for each kit"

We do purchase CD audiobooks if available.

Unfortunately, not ever title has a physical audiobook.

"Make sure an ebook or digital audiobook is available in Kentucky Libraries Unbound"

We do purchase ebooks and digital audiobooks when possible.

"Include a DVD of the movie in the kit"

We are unable to do this due to issues with public performance rights.

"Purchase more copies of popular kits"

We do this on a case-by-case basis, but we have a limited budget for kits

If we purchase multiple copies for several kits, it limits the number of new kit titles we can purchase per year.

"Please include questions that go with the book in the discussion guide. Some have generic questions."

Our newest kits all have unique discussion questions in the guides.

We are addressing guides with generic questions as time permits.

"Please do a periodic review of discussion guides and questions."

Staffing coupled with the number of kits makes this very difficult.

"Please include copy numbers on the slips"

We do not have the option to do that with our system.

If copy numbers are on your check out slips, they have been added manually by Alexis.

(Thank you, Alexis!!)

"We did not receive all 15 (or 20) copies of the kit."

Unfortunately, not all kits have 15 (or 20) copies

We are not always able to replace lost or damaged copies.

Some copies may be still checked out to a previous library.

Check our catalog for the most accurate number of books in a kit.
