2023 Annual Report Changes

The following are important additions, deletions, and modifications to the Kentucky Annual Report of Public Libraries for FY23:

- Item number B11a LSTA CARES Act Grant is removed from the Federal Government Revenue Section.
- Questions related to the COVID-19 pandemic are removed. This includes Section D and the closed/limited occupancy questions.
- Item M1 Other Measures of Library Use is changed to M1 Name or Description of Other Measure of Use to clarify what is being asked.
- Item M2 Use Statistics is changed to M2 Numerical Statistic of Measure in M1 to clarify what is being asked.
- Item O38 Total Views of Recorded Program Presentations within 7 Days is changed to within 30 Days.
- The note on item R1 Number of Intellectual Freedom Challenges is clarified to reflect it is asking for the number of challenge incidents, not the number of titles: A challenge is an attempt to remove or restrict materials, based upon the objections of a person or group. Record the number of incidents, not the number of titles.

A new item is added:

H20 As of the end of the reporting period, does the library charge overdue fines to any users when they fail to return physical print materials by the date due?
