RDA and Cataloger's Judgment : "With great power comes great responsibility"

- Once core elements are satisfied, RDA relies heavily on cataloger's judgment
- Many options and alternatives
- **Record your decisions for future reference!**

New MARC Fields for Bibliographic Records

264 Field Production, Publication, Distribution, Manufacture, and Copyright Notice

- 2nd Indicator
 - 0 = Production Information
 - 1 = Publication Information
 - 2 = Distribution Information
 - 3 = Manufacture Information
 - 4 = Copyright notice date
- Subfields
 - a = Place of publication, etc.
 - b = Name of publisher, etc.
 - c = Date of publication, copyright date
- Can have multiple 264 fields to record different roles.
 - 264_1 \$a Spokane, WA :\$b Books in Motion, \$c [2005]
 - 264_4 \$a ©2005

*No period at end of 264_4 as per LC Practice.

- 336 Content type – RDA 6.9
- 337 Media type – RDA 3.2
- 338 Carrier type – RDA 3.3
- Subfields
 - \$a term
 - \$b code
 - \$2 "rdaccontent" or "rdamedia" or "rdacarrier" as appropriate
 - \$3 materials specified - give if appropriate

**340 Field
Physical Medium**

- "Physical description information for an item that requires technical equipment for its use or an item that has special conservation or storage needs"
- Subfields
 - a = Material base and configuration
 - b = Dimensions
 - n = Font size – used for large print materials.
- 340 \$a marble (physical medium for a sculpture)
- 340 \$a parchment \$b 20 cm. folded to 10 x 12 cm.
- 340 \$n large print or \$n large print (36 point)

**344 Field
Sound Characteristics (RDA 3.16)**

- "Technical specifications relating to the encoding of sound in a resource."
- Some information also coded in 007
- Subfields
 - \$a = Type of recording (analog, digital) – RDA 3.16.2
 - \$b = Recording medium (magnetic, optical, etc.) – RDA 3.16.3
 - \$c = Playing speed -- RDA 3.16.4
 - \$g = Configuration of playback channels – RDA 3.16.8
 - \$h = Special playback characteristics – RDA 3.16.9
 - \$2 = Source of terms
- 344 \$a digital \$b optical \$g stereo \$h Dolby Digital \$2 rda

345 Field
Projection Characteristics of Moving Image (RDA 3.17)

- Technical specifications relating to the projection of a moving image resource
- Subfields
 - \$a - Presentation format (RDA 3.17.2)
 - \$b - Projection speed (RDA 3.17.3)
 - \$2 - Source of terms

346 Field
Video Characteristics (RDA 3.18)

- "Technical specifications relating to the encoding of analog video images in a resource."
- Subfields
 - \$a = Video format (Beta, VHS, not DVD) – RDA 3.18.2
 - \$b = Broadcast standard (PAL, NTSC) – RDA 3.18.3

346 \$a VHS \$b NTSC \$2 rda

347 Field
Digital File Characteristics (RDA 3.19)

- "Technical specification relating to the digital encoding of text, image, audio, video, and other types of data in a resource."
- Subfields:
 - \$a = File type (audio file, video file, text file, data file, etc.) – RDA 3.19.2
 - \$b = Encoding format (can use terms at RDA 3.19.3.3) – RDA 3.19.3
 - \$c = File size – RDA 3.19.4
 - \$d = Resolution – RDA 3.19.5
 - \$e = Regional encoding – RDA 3.19.6
 - \$f = Transmission speed – RDA 3.19.7
 - \$2 = Source of term

Cataloging Special Formats with RDA

- ### What's Different?
- No General Material Designation in the \$h of the 245 field
 - 264 instead of 260 for publication information.
 - New MARC fields
 - 336, 337, 338, 340, 344-347
 - No abbreviations in transcribed fields unless it appears on the resource
 - Some abbreviations in 300 field
 - Relationship designators in 1XX and 7XX fields

- ### Methods to express relationships
1. Authorized access point:
 - 110 2_ \$a Society of Linguists, \$e author.
 2. Structured description:
 - 776 08 \$i Also issued as: \$t Health statistics
 3. Unstructured description:
 - 500 __ \$a Translation of the author's novel Digital fortress.

Sources

- Preferred source of information = source of title proper
- Three categories
 - Pages, leaves, etc., or images of pages ... -- RDA 2.2.2.2
 - Moving images – RDA 2.2.2.3
 - All other resources – RDA 2.2.2.4
- Divided into tangible and online resources
- Enclose in brackets if from outside the resource or supplied by cataloger

**Cataloging Sound Recordings
with RDA**

Sources

- Source: Other Resources (RDA 2.2.2.4)
- Preferred source of information = label on resource
- If source shows individual titles, choose source that has collective title.
 - Container or accompanying material

RDA Differences – 2XX Fields

- No GMD [sound recording] in the 245 field
- Performers not transcribed in statement of responsibility ; not recorded in 1XX field
 - Unless they are the creator of the work(s)
- Can use additional 264 for phonogram/copyright date
 - 264 _4 \$c ©2006

RDA Differences – 300 Field

- In Extent, use “audio discs” instead of “sound discs”
- Have the option to use a term in common usage in the extent (300 \$a)
 - Can use terms such as CD, DVD and Blu-Ray

300 \$a 12 audio discs ...
300 \$a 10 CDs (instead of 10 audio discs)
- Don't use “ca.” in Duration, use “approximately” instead

300 \$a 12 audio discs (approximately 12 hr.) ...

Still the same, 300 Field

- Duration – still recorded in 300 field \$a
- Dimensions – still recorded in 300 field \$c
 - RDA says to use cm, LC still using inches for discs
- Abbreviations for duration and measurement are still used
 - hr., min., sec., in., etc.

300 \$a 12 audio discs (approximately 12 hr.) ; \$c 4 3/4 in.

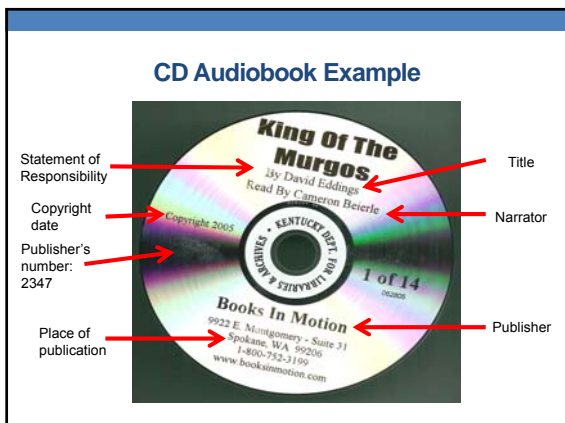

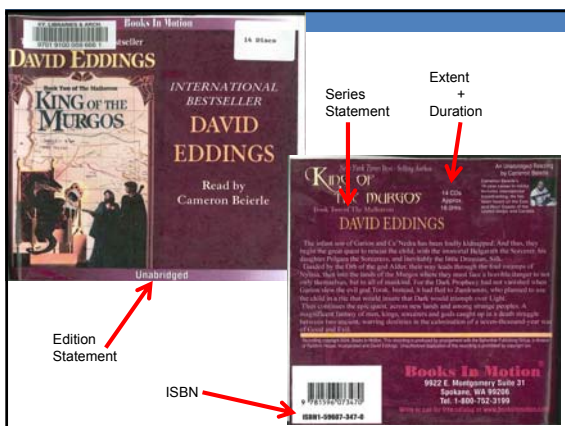

- Preferred source of information = title frame or screen
- If no title frame or screen, use first of following with title:
 - Label
 - Container or accompanying material
 - Disc menu
- If source shows individual titles, choose source that has collective title.
 - Container or accompanying material

RDA Differences – 300 Field

- In Extent, you have the option to use a term in common usage in the extent (300 \$a)
 - Can use terms such as CD, DVD and Blu-Ray

300 \$a 1 videodisc ...

300 \$a 1 Blu-Ray ...

- Don't use "ca." in Duration, use "approximately" instead

- In the 300 \$b, color and sound are not abbreviated

with RDA**

Sources

- **eBook**
 - Preferred source of information = title page or image of title page
 - If no title page, use first of following with title:
 - Image of: cover, caption, masthead or colophon
- **Video**
 - Preferred source of information = title frame or screen
 - If no title frame or screen, use first of following with title:
 - Textual content
 - Embedded metadata
- **Audio**
 - Preferred source of information = Textual content, embedded metadata

RDA Differences – 300 Field

- In Extent (300 \$a), use "1 online resource"
 - Can add subunits, file size and duration in parentheses

300 \$a 1 online resource (25 pages)
300 \$a 1 online resource (1 audio file (30 min.))
300 \$a 1 online resource (1 video file (25 min.))

- Can include other physical details in 300 \$b

300 \$a 1 online resource (25 pages) : \$b illustrations
300 \$a 1 online resource (1 video file (25 min.)) : \$b
sound, color

- Do not include dimensions (300 \$c)

MARC 3XX Fields

Source of Description Note (588)

- Used to note basis of record description
- Is record based on online resource?
- Can combine with Source of title note

588 \$a Description based on online resource; title from PDF title page (viewed on May 26, 2011).

- Is record based on record for the physical format?
- Use phrase: Description based on [physical format] version record.

588 \$a Description based on print version record.
588 \$a Description based on CD-ROM version record.

Additional Physical Form Entry (776)

- Used if description is based on record for another format

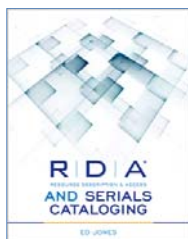

From the RDA Glossary—

“A resource issued in successive parts, usually having numbering, that has no predetermined conclusion (e.g., a periodical, a monographic series, a newspaper). Includes resources that exhibit characteristics of serials, such as successive issues, numbering, and frequency, but whose duration is limited (e.g., newsletters of events) and reproductions of serials.” (Also found at **RDA 2.13.1.3**—Recording Modes of Issuance.)

General observations about serials—

- Elaborate cataloging records, found in the catalogs of academic libraries
- Acquired through costly subscriptions—requires a claim process when an issues does not arrive
- Great importance in academic research

- Important need for consumer information, health and wellness topics
- Local newspaper collections
- Also acquired through costly subscription

Serials, the online catalog, and library customers—

- Interpreting serial records in the online catalog can be challenging, even for librarians
- Even dedicated researchers get lost in the details of serials cataloging
- Presenting serials information to public library users
- Some libraries provide inventory information for serials through other means—lists, web pages

Serials, RDA, Public Libraries and Customers

Consideration for ALL libraries—

Access to electronic resources

- most often through a service (OverDrive, eBrary, Zinio, others)
- may have catalog records
- subscription databases—citation, full-text, include important serials resources (KYVL)

Serials, RDA, Public Libraries and Customers

Serials considerations for public libraries—

- How much is being invested in serial resources?
- How do customers access serials information now?
- Are cataloging resources available for serials work?
- What are your interlibrary loan policies?

Serials, RDA, Public Libraries and Customers

Serials and resource sharing—

- Allows libraries to provide access to journal information for titles they do not subscribe to, and for issues they no longer retain.
- Requires serials information shared in OCLC (Online Computer Library Center)

- KDLA pays all costs associated with union listing. The library periodically provides the necessary information to update the library's holdings on OCLC to KULS at KDLA.
- For interlibrary loan, KULS work provides information about which libraries in Kentucky hold the titles and volumes your library's users need.
- No matter how small your library's collection, do not underestimate it. Your library may hold serials titles that are unique in Kentucky. Local journals, newsletters, and periodicals are often found only in local libraries. You may be the only library in the area that is able to provide what some ILL client is desperate to find.

Reporting holdings information to KULS—

- **Email**—Most participating libraries send their updates to the KULS office by attaching a Word document containing this information to an email message to KULS@ky.gov.
- **Printouts from local systems**—Some libraries acquire and mail printouts from their system administrators. These are acceptable as long as they contain all the required bibliographic information, and list only those titles that have had holdings changes since the last update. This method is often used by libraries that are adding their holdings to KULS for the first time.

- addresses many issues regarding pre-cataloging decisions and analysis of complex library resources, including distinctions between modes of issuance, print and electronic materials, serials and integrating resources

Serials, RDA, Public Libraries and Customers

RDA and Serials—

Integrating resources—a resource that is added to or changed by means of updates that do not remain discrete but are integrated into the whole (e.g., a loose-leaf manual that is updated by means of replacement pages, a website that is updated continuously) (RDA 2.13.1.3)

Serials as electronic resources—If the resource was/is published in print, make the decision to catalog the electronic resource as a serial, integrating resource, or monograph based on the electronic resource itself, not on how it was issued in print. Information about the planned type of issuance may be given in the resource’s “read me” files, etc. (LC-PCC PS at RDA 0.0).

RDA and Serials—
Changes requiring a new description (RDA 1.6)
Serials (RDA 1.6.2)—mode of issuance, carrier, title, responsibility and edition
Integrating resources (RDA 1.6.3)—mode of issuance, media type, “re-basing,” edition

—may, or may not, require a new descriptions.

- LC CORE ELEMENT
- Always give in a CONSER Standard Record
- Multipart monographs and serials: if not based on first issue or part (**LCPS 2.20.13.3**)
- Integrating resources: latest iteration consulted
- Any online resource: date resource viewed
- MARC 588 field
