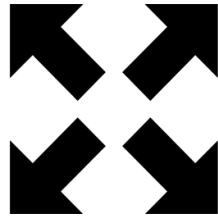

Tip for Viewing Demo

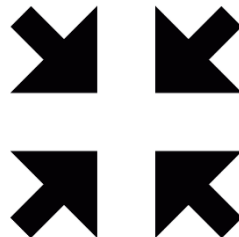
To switch to full screen during the Photoshop demo:

- Move your cursor to the top of share pod
- Click on the Full Screen icon in the gray menu bar at the top of the pod:



The pods for chat and closed captioning are not visible in full screen mode.

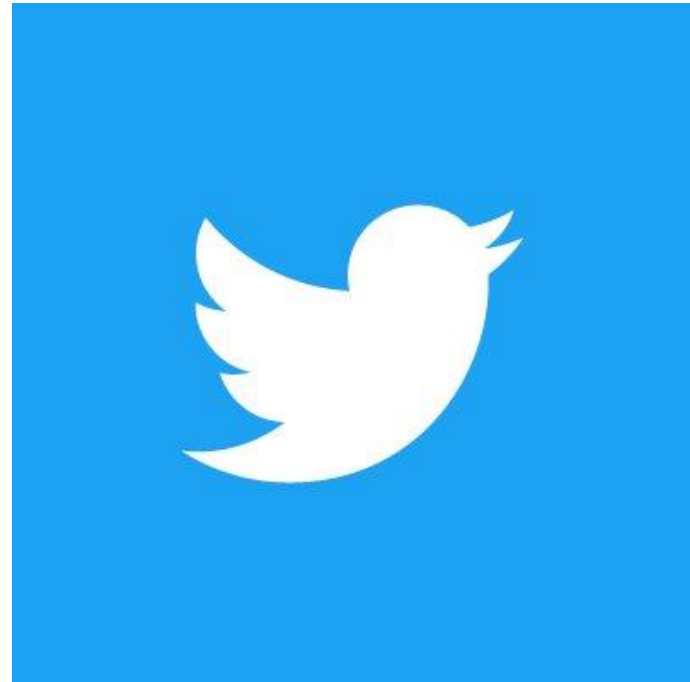
