

LIBRARIES 2016

The latest Pew Research Center report on libraries came out in September. Here are some interesting stats on public opinion about digital literacy skills and technology:

“When asked to think about how libraries might change to better serve the public, Americans have a pretty clear message: help people learn digital skills without neglecting traditional functions. Specifically:

- 80% of those ages 16 and older say libraries should “definitely” offer programs to teach people, including kids and senior citizens, how to use digital tools like computers and smartphones. This is a similar pattern captured in a 2015 survey.
- 57% think libraries should “definitely” have more comfortable spaces for reading and working. This is down slightly from the 64% who said this in 2015.
- 50% believe libraries should “definitely” buy 3-D printers and other digital tools to allow people to use them. This compares with 45% who said this in 2015.
- 24% say libraries should “definitely” move some print books and stacks out of public locations in order to free up more space for such things as tech centers, reading rooms and meeting rooms. This is a decrease from the 30% who said this in 2015.”





HOW PATRONS SEE YOUR SITE

- **20% of households connect to the internet solely through mobile devices according to a study by the National Telecommunications and Information Administration (NTIA)**

- **Why does this matter to Kentucky libraries?**
 - In a survey from 2015, only 21% of Kentucky library websites employed responsive design.

HOTSPOTS (1/2)



- More public libraries are loaning mobile Wi-Fi hotspots to patrons.
- Portable—can be used at home, on the bus, in the park, or anywhere the carrier's cellular network reaches



BIBFRAME AND LIBRARY.LINK

- **BIBFRAME = Bibliographic Framework Initiative**
 - Library of Congress working with management company Zepheira to develop an initiative to evolve bibliographic description standards to a linked data model, in order to make bibliographic information more useful both within and outside the library community.








