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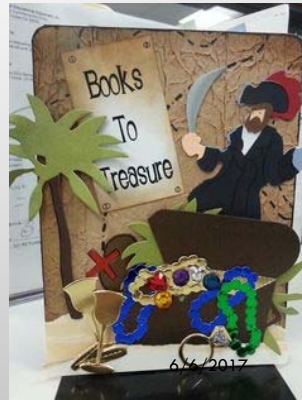

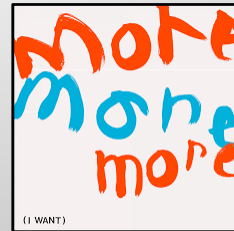

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DEEP SEA DIVING: BUOYANCY

- <http://www.startwithabook.org/content/pdfs/DeepSeaDiver.pdf>
- Show participants a group of objects and ask them to predict which will sink and which will float. Then, test their ideas using a plastic container filled with water.
- Have small groups of participants build a small diver (no larger than 3 in. x 3 in.) that is neutrally buoyant.
- Place the diver into a container of water and test its buoyancy.

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WATER

- Goal: To build awareness of how we see and use water
- Invite guest who works with water systems (plumbers, treatment plant employees) to share their knowledge.
- Encourage them to bring tools or supplies to help demonstrate what they do.
- Keep journal or water use log
- Discuss ways to conserve water

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FOOD FROM THE SEA

- Have participants share simple seafood recipes
- Have dietician or nutritionist discuss nutritional value of fish
- Have seafood cooking demonstration by local chef



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MYSTERIES AT SEA

- Investigate books, stories and/or articles about unexplained phenomena pertaining to oceans and seas

- Bermuda Triangle
- Ghost ships
- Superstitions



- Have a discussion or debate to prove or disprove one of the mysteries

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TREASURE HUNT



- Organize treasure hunt in and around library for participants
- Have them search online, reference sources, stacks and other areas to track down answers to clues
- May want to divide participants into different groups and have a different set of clues to follow for each

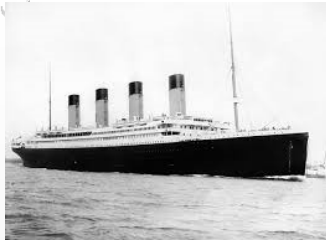

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VICTORY AT SEA

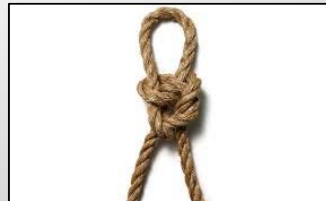
- Documentary TV series

- Build model ships
- Tie ships knots
- Learn semaphore or Morse code
- Make nautical flags



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MAKE A CINQUAIN

- Pronounced (sin-cane)
- Non-rhyming five-line poem that focuses on imagery and the natural world
- Rules of the Game:

Line 1: One word title, a noun that identifies your topic

Line 2: Two adjectives that describe your topic

Line 3: Three "ing" verbs that describe action

Line 4: A phrase that describes something about your topic

Line 5: A noun that is a synonym or another way to name your topic

- You'll need to do research to know your facts and develop an authentic voice!
- Write a series of 15-20 tweets that reveal your character, your times, professional challenges, interactions with other townspeople, and what you do for fun. You may add links and hashtags to your tweets.

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MYTHS AND LEGENDS

- Examine Greek, Roman or Norse sea gods mythology
- Explore folklore tales about mermaids and sea monsters
- Study the legends of lost worlds such as Atlantis
- Have participants create their own stories based on sea lore
