- 1. Obtain a Temporary Certificate
- ◆ Complete orientations led by your library director and regional consultant. Two orientation videos may be substituted for the regional's orientation.
- The Temporary Certificate is valid for two years.



- Obtain the KY
 Public Library
 Trustee Certificate
- ◆ Complete KDLA's training program on the Public Library Trustee Core Skills.
- ◆ The Trustee Certificate is valid for four years.

- 3. Renew Your Certificate
- Complete eight hours of training in the Core Skills categories.
- A renewed Certificate is valid for four years.
