# INTRODUCTION

The *Statistical Report of Kentucky Public Libraries, Fiscal Year 2021-2022* contains information taken from the Annual Report of Public Libraries.

## Reporting Library Information in the Time of COVID-19

The Statistical Report is changed this year. Three sections are no longer included -- selected statistics, special statistics, and the top ten pages ranking libraries by values, per capita calculations, or other service measures. The significance of ranking libraries this year is diminished due to the wide range of weeks open and services offered as libraries reacted to the pandemic. These ranks are more likely to reflect closures or limited occupancy than be a basis for good comparison.

Two items are added to the report this year:

- **#85** – Total Number of Self-Directed Activities
- **#86** – Total Participants in Self-Directed Activities

Data was not collected for three counties due to devastating floods in Eastern Kentucky. Owsley, Knott, and Magoffin Counties were not able to submit annual reports.

Per capita calculations are based on the estimated total state population provided by the Kentucky State Data Center. This includes Owsley, Knott, and Magoffin County. Corbin's population is part of Whitley County's figure.

Editor's note – This publication marks the thirty-third and final Statistical Report that I have worked on. I retire in March 2023. My hope is that I have provided a useful, easy to navigate collection of library information. Great thanks to co-workers at KDLA and librarians throughout Kentucky for your suggestions to make this a better report. I hope that I have been successful.

## GLOSSARY

- **ALA-MLS**  
Librarians with master's degrees from programs of library and information studies accredited by the American Library Association.
- **Annual Public Service Hours**  
Sum of all public service hours for all central libraries, branches, and bookmobiles. Includes limited occupancy.
- **Audio – Physical Units**  
Includes sound recordings stored in a fixed, physical format
- **Audio – Downloadable Units**  
These are downloadable electronic files on which sounds are stored, and that can be played back electronically
- **Book Turnover**  
Total book circulation divided by total book collection.
- **Bookmobile**  
A truck or van that carries an organized collection of library materials, has paid staff, and regularly scheduled hours (bookmobile stops) for being open to the public.
- **Branch Library**  
Auxiliary unit of an administrative entity which has all of the following: (1) separate quarters, (2) an organized collection of library materials, (3) paid staff, and (4) regularly scheduled hours for being open to the public.
- **Budget Expenditures**  
Sum of costs for collection, personnel, and operations.
- **Capital Expenditures**  
Major capital expenditures (the acquisition of or additions to fixed assets). Examples include expenditures for (a) site acquisitions; (b) new buildings; (c) additions to or renovation of library buildings; (d) furnishings, equipment, and initial book stock for new buildings, building additions, or building renovations; (e) library automation systems; (f) new vehicles; and (g) other one time major projects.
- **Capital Revenue**  
Revenue to be used for major capital expenditures. Examples include funds received for a) site acquisition; b) new buildings; c) additions to or renovation of library buildings; d) furnishings, equipment, and initial book stock for new buildings, building additions, or building renovations; e) library automation systems; f) new vehicles; and g) and other one time major projects.

## GLOSSARY

- **Children's Program Attendance**  
The count of the audience at all programs for which the primary audience is children 11 years and under. Includes adults who attend programs intended primarily for children.
- **Circulation**  
Materials in all formats that are charged out for use outside the library, including renewals.
- **Use of Electronic Material**  
Electronic Materials are materials that are distributed digitally and can be accessed via a computer, the Internet, or a portable device such as an e-book reader. Types of electronic materials include e-books and downloadable electronic video and audio files.
- **Electronic Books (E-Books)**  
These are digital documents (including those digitized by the library), licensed or not, where searchable text is prevalent, and which can be seen in analogy to a printed book (monograph). Includes non-serial government documents. E-books are loaned to users on portable devices (e-book readers) or by transmitting the contents to the user's personal computer for a limited time
- **FTE (Full Time Equivalent)**  
To ensure comparable national data use the following calculation for budgeted positions:  
*Hours worked by employees in a position / 40*
- **General Operating Expenditures**  
Library costs including supplies, rent, fees, building maintenance, postage, etc.
- **Intellectual Freedom Incidents**  
The number of challenged works.
- **Local Government Revenue**  
All local government funds designated by the community, district, or region and available for expenditure by the public library. Does not include the value of any contributed or in-kind services, or the value of any gifts and donations, library fines, fees or grants.
- **Material Circulated, Central Library**  
Total material circulated in central library only.
- **Material Circulation Per Capita**  
Sum of all material circulated for the central library, branches, and bookmobiles, divided by population.
- **Other Operating Revenue**  
This is all operating revenue other than that reported under local, state, and federal.
- **People Entering Library**  
Attendance. The total number of persons entering the library for whatever purpose during the year.
- **Population**  
The latest county population estimates as released by the Kentucky Data Center.

## GLOSSARY

- **Recorded Program Presentations**

The count of views of asynchronous program presentations for a period of seven (7) days after the presentation was posted
- **Reference Transaction**

An information contact which involves the knowledge, use, recommendations, interpretation, or instruction in the use of one or more information sources by a member of the library staff.
- **Total Electronic Access Costs**

Operating Expenditures for Electronic Access includes computer hardware and software used to support library operations, whether purchased or leased, mainframe and microcomputer. Includes expenditures for maintenance, and for equipment used to run information service products when that expenditure can be separated from the price of the product.
- **Total Library Staff**

Sum of total librarians and all other paid staff funded in the library's budget, expressed as FTE.
- **Total Material Circulated**

Total of all material circulated for the central library, branches, and bookmobiles.
- **Total Operating Expenditures**

The sum of expenses for general operations, bookmobiles, computers, and continuing education.
- **Total Operating Revenue**

Sum of local, state, federal, and other operating revenue.
- **Total Staff Expense**

Salaries and benefits.
- **Users of Electronic Resources Per Year**

The annual number of users of electronic resources in the library. Electronic resources include, but are not limited to, Internet (WWW, email, other), online indexes, CD-ROM reference materials, software, and the online catalog. Does not include staff use of these resources.
- **Video – Physical Units**

These are materials circulated in a fixed, physical format on which moving pictures are recorded, with or without sound.
- **Video – Downloadable Units**

These are downloadable electronic files on which moving pictures are recorded, with or without sound. Electronic playback reproduces pictures, with or without sound, using a television receiver, computer monitor or video-enabled mobile device.
- **Virtual Programs**

Any planned event that is streamed virtually and can be viewed live as it progresses (i.e., live-streaming)
- **Website Visits**

Visits represent the annual number of sessions initiated by all users from inside/outside the library to the library website.
