- Each year, more than 40,000 people in the U.S. are killed in motor vehicle collisions
- > In the U.S., motor vehicle collisions are largest cause of death for people ages 3-34
- Risk can be reduced by managing your time, space and visibility.

# Can You See Where You're Going?

- Just how good are your eyes?
- > Equipment: Windshield, Headlights
- > Stop tunnel vision: SCAN! SCAN! SCAN!
- > Looking 20-30 seconds ahead (1/3 of a mile) gives you more time to react



# Know Thy Vehicle

- > Safety Checks: Bottoms up! Inside and Ou
- > Headlights: Conventional vs. High Intensity
- > Tires: Pressure, Min 2/3" Tread, Ratings
- > 8 and 4 Hand Position
- > Abilities: Car vs. SUV

- > Excessive Speed KILLS
- Buckle Up
- Distracted Driving: Cell Phones, Grooming, Eating, Reading, Radio, Passengers, etc
- Fatigue
