- > Each year, more than 40,000 people in the U.S. are killed in motor vehicle collisions
- > In the U.S., motor vehicle collisions are largest cause of death for people ages 3-34
- > Risk can be reduced by managing your time, space and visibility.

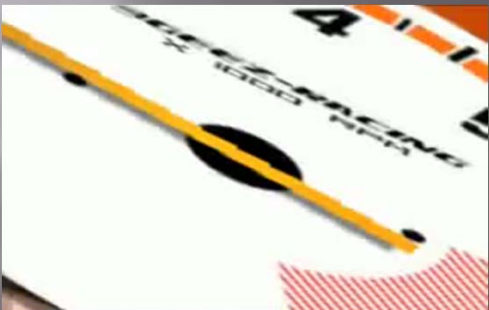
What Can You See?



Can You See Where You're Going?

- > Just how good are your eyes?
- > Equipment: Windshield, Headlights
- > Stop tunnel vision: SCAN! SCAN! SCAN!
- > Looking 20-30 seconds ahead (1/3 of a mile) gives you more time to react

Blind Spots Be Gone!



Know Thy Vehicle

- > Safety Checks: Bottoms up! Inside and Out
- > Headlights: Conventional vs. High Intensity
- > Tires: Pressure, Min 2/3" Tread, Ratings
- > 8 and 4 Hand Position
- > Abilities: Car vs. SUV



Seven Deadly Drives



DANGER!

- Excessive Speed KILLS
- Buckle Up
- Distracted Driving: Cell Phones, Grooming, Eating, Reading, Radio, Passengers, etc
- Fatigue

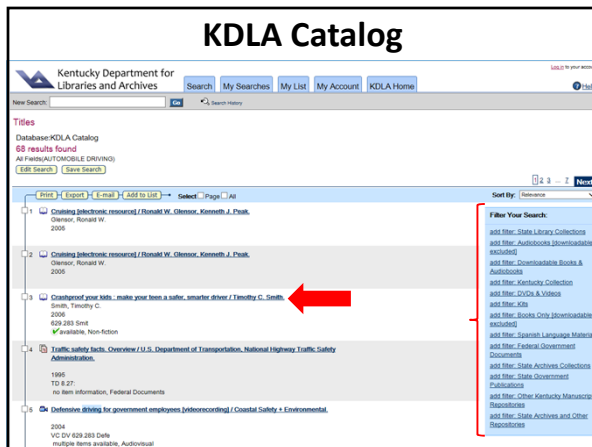
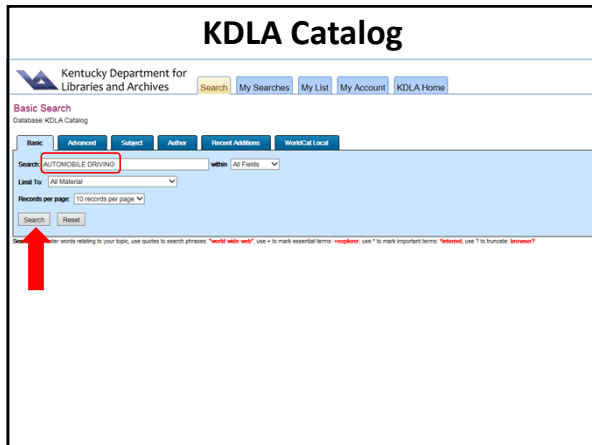
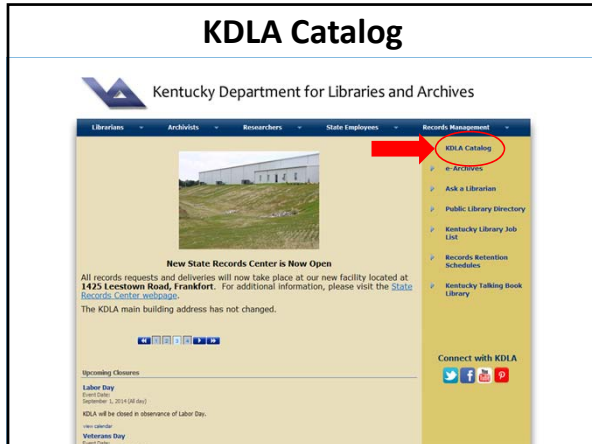

Downloading Audiobooks and Ebooks

State government employees can download digital audiobooks and ebooks due to a partnership agreement with Kentucky Libraries Unbound (KLU). Members of the general public should check with their [local public libraries](#) about downloadable digital resources available to them.

Autosave You may download resources over the Internet using your home computer or personal devices. If you want to download titles at work, you must adhere to your agency's IT policies. You cannot use any library's public computers to download titles.

Before you start:

- You must have a valid State Library account to download titles. If you need to sign up for an account, [click here](#).
- If you have lost your account number, contact the Reference desk through [Ask a Librarian](#) or by calling 502.564.8200, ext. 342 or 800.926.7000, ext. 342.

Getting Started in KLU:

- Set up/login to your account
- Connect to Kentucky Libraries Unbound and look for "Account" in the top right hand corner.
- Select "No Email for Libraries and Archives" as your library. When prompted, enter your last name and your State Library account number.

Getting ready to download audiobooks, videos and music:

- Install the OverDrive Media Console on your computer or the OverDrive Media Console App on your mobile device [click for PDF instructions](#).
- Connect to [Kentucky Libraries Unbound](#) and look for "Help" in the top right hand corner. From the Help page, [click on the Software tab](#).
- For Windows Computers only: A security upgrade may be required so OverDrive Media Console can play protected titles. When prompted, follow the screens to complete the upgrade.

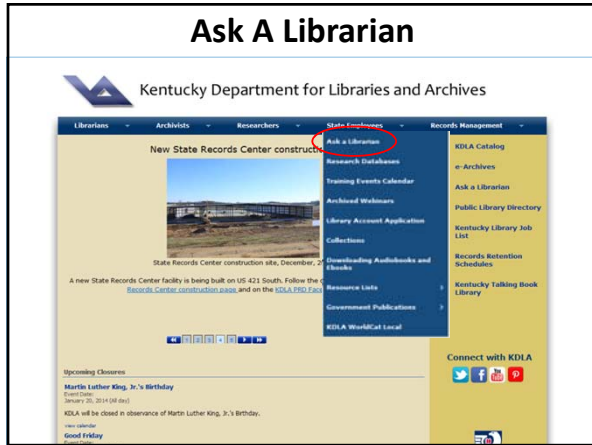
