

WHAT ARE THE EBSCO*HOST* DATABASES?

KYVL's EBSCO*host* database offerings:

- Include 26 databases geared toward the research needs of academic, medical, business, public school, public library, government, & military organizations
- > Contain both abstracts and full-text articles
- > Include more than 300,000 title listings
- > Allow you to search multiple databases simultaneously
- > Allow you to set up a free personal account

EBSCO*HOST* DATABASES

Academic

- Academic Search Complete/Premier scholarly peer-reviewed journals, FT
- FRIC education literature and resources/articles, citations and FT
- Funk & Wagnalls New World Encyclopedia over 25,000 encyclopedia entries
- Library, Information Science & Technology Abstracts abstracts only, everything library, articles dating back to mid 1960s
- MAS Ultra School Edition specifically for high school, over 500 popular high school magazines and 360 FT reference books, also biographies, primary source documents
- Middle Search Plus popular middle school magazines, LEXILE reading level indicators for each FT article, also biographies, historical essays, maps
- Primary Search magazines for elementary school research, LEXILE, FT
- Teacher Reference Center indexing of teacher and administrator journals, abstracts only
- American Doctoral Dissertations, 1933-1955 provides electronic access to the only comprehensive record of dissertations accepted by American universities for the specified time period, citations only

- PsycINFO APA database, scholarly literature in behavioral science and mental health, 99% content peer reviewed, abstracts only
- Sociological Collection information all areas of sociology, FT peer reviewed titles

Business

- Business Source Premier business articles on accounting, economics, finance, management, etc., FT
- Regional Business News business publications, all US metropolitan, rural, FT
- > Small Business Reference Center resources for small business owners and those interested in starting a business, FT

EBSCO*HOST* DATABASES

Health/Medical

- CINAHL & CINAHL with Full-Text nursing and allied health, citations hand some FT
- Health Source Consumer Edition information/articles from consumer health magazines, FT
- MEDLINE created by National Library of Medicine, authoritative, Ascholarly medical information, some FT
- **RHFS Consumer Medication Information trusted source and recognized standard for patient drug information, FT

Miscellaneous

- Agricola USDA's National Agricultural Library, abstracts only
- GreenFILE environmental issues, citations and some FT
- eBook Collection search for e-books, FT, many are classics that are public domain, PDF format



Periodicals


- MasterFILE Premier contains general interest magazines, designed specifically for public libraries, coverage back to 1975, FT
- Newspaper Source regional, national US newspapers, television, radio news transcripts, FT
- TOPICsearch articles from 475 diverse sources including international and regional newspapers, periodicals, biographies, public opinion polls, book reviews, pamphlets, FT










































SEARCHING TIPS


- Wildcard: use #to replace a character in a word in order to get all variations of that word. Ex.: wom#n
- Truncation: use * to search the root or plural of a word. Ex.: manag*, infant*
- Double Quotations: use ". . ." for phrases. Ex.: "Kentucky State Hospital"


SEARCHING TIPS


- Boolean Operators: use AND, OR, and NOT operators to combine or exclude keywords in your search. Ex.: salary OR income, bears NOT grizzly
- Parentheses: use () to control and define the way the search will be executed. Ex.: (dog or cat) and (show or parade)











































- Notice when something new is added to database






CREATING JOURNAL ALERTS
